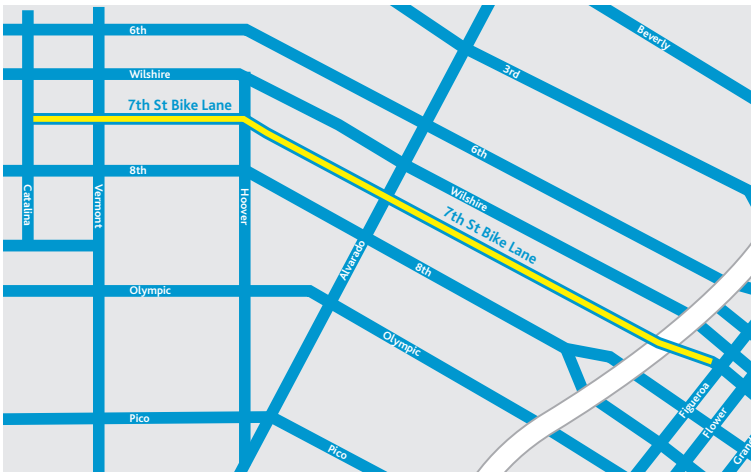


Bike Lanes are coming to your neighborhood by October 2011!

The City of LA is getting ready to implement bike lanes along 7th Street, spanning from Catalina Street to Figueroa Street in Downtown LA. After further study, a second phase will extend the bike lanes to Boyle Heights.

2.2 miles of bike lanes will pass through the following neighborhoods:

- Koreatown
- Westlake/MacArthur Park
- The Financial District

Bike Lane Benefits:

In the past five years, there have been 376 car accidents on this part of 7th Street. 49 have involved pedestrians and 27 have involved bicyclists. The bike lanes will make 7th Street safer for bicyclists and pedestrians and support healthy lifestyles, as the City will remove a travel lane and slow traffic. Other benefits of this project are:

- Will not reduce car speeds significantly
- No loss of on-street parking
- Better access and more business for businesses along 7th St
- More room on sidewalks for pedestrians because bicyclists will be using bike lanes
- More trips by bike and walking leads to less congestion

The first phase of design was completed in March. We need your input and suggestions for the final design, so that the bike lane can reflect your needs!
